OUR MONTH OF SEPTEMBER SAINT: ST VINCENT DE PAUL FEAST DAY: SEPTMEBER 27



Saint Vincent de Paul was an Occitan Catholic Priest who dedicated himself to serving the poor.

In 1622 Vincent was appointed a chaplain to the galley. After working for some time in Paris among imprisoned galley slaves, he returned to be the superior of what is now known as the Congregation of the Mission, or the "Vincentians" (in France known as "Lazaristes"), which he co-founded.

He was renowned for his compassion, humility, and generosity. Vincent was canonized in 1737 and is venerated as a Saint in both the Catholic Church and the Anglican Church.
